



Youth Group Confidentiality Policy

At Maple Grove Christian Church we believe it is the parents responsibility to oversee the spiritual formation of their children. With this in mind, the youth leaders and pastors will not withhold crucial information from a parent in regard to their child.

Our hope is that our parents will be intentional about involving their children in conversations in regards to issues that are important to them. We also hope that our children will be able to find mentors and friends outside their family that can reinforce their families' Christian values, morals and beliefs.

If, at any point, a youth leader is concerned that a youth group member's activities or attitudes are life-threatening to themselves or others, that youth leader will notify the Pastor in charge who will communicate this concern to the parents along with all pertinent information. Situations involving severe substance abuse, suicidal thoughts or actions, violent thoughts or behaviors are examples of these circumstances.

Any concerns or confessions of premarital sexual activity will be immediately communicated to the Pastor in charge who will contact the parents and pass along all pertinent information.

If you as a student or parent have any concerns in regards to this policy, please contact the Pastor overseeing the Youth Group Ministry. If you are aware of any behaviors by a Maple Grove Christian Church Youth Group member that might violate this policy please let the Pastor know of such activities.
